Initial \$1000 Scholarship Guidelines for 2023-24 High School Students

- 1. Applicant must be residing in or attending a Nodaway County school district.
- 2. Applicant must be a high school senior with a GPA of 3.0/4.0 or better to be eligible for the scholarship.
- 3. Applicant must demonstrate leadership potential through extracurricular activities and work experiences. Applicant may also demonstrate a need for financial assistance.
- 4. Handwritten and/or incomplete applications will **not** be accepted.
- 5. Preference may be given to students with their area of study in the field of agriculture and food production. Special preference may be given for areas of study related to beef production. Students pursuing non-agricultural degrees are *encouraged* to apply as <u>EACH</u> Nodaway County school will receive one scholarship if all criteria is met. At-large scholarships will be awarded to additional Nodaway County applicants as needed if applications are not received from all Nodaway County school districts.
- 6. Applications must be a postmarked by December 1, 2023 and mailed to:

- 7. Nodaway County Cattlemen's Association Board Members will review applications and inform recipients of scholarship recipients in January 2024.
- 8. Scholarship recipients are expected to receive their scholarships in person.

One-Year Renewable \$1000 Scholarship Guidelines

Applicants must have been awarded a Nodaway County Cattlemen's Association Scholarship in 2024 or after –AND- meet the following guidelines:

- 1. Attend a post-secondary school majoring or minoring in an agriculture related field
- 2. Completed a minimum of 12 credit hours in the Fall and Spring semester of 2024-25 while maintaining a 2.5 GPA or above
- 3. Attend a post-secondary school in 2025-26 as a full-time student
- 4. Submit official transcripts verifying the above information by August 15, 2025 to:
