The Cody Lee Stiens Memorial Scholarship Fund Application

Purpose and Scope of Scholarship

The Cody Lee Stiens Memorial Scholarship Fund was created to assist students in Nodaway County Missouri, who desire to attend Trade/Technical School with the goal of obtaining a degree or certification leading towards employment in a related field.

The scholarship is named in memory of Cody Lee Stiens who grew up and attended school in Nodaway County and upon completion of his education was an extremely talented HVAC systems engineer for several large firms. Cody was also in the process of starting his own consulting business at the time of his passing. Cody was a very passionate advocate for Trade/Tech education and employment.

It is the sincere hope of the scholarship fund that deserving students will benefit from the award of financial assistance and give back to the communities in Nodaway County through trade and technical employment.

General Guidelines

- 1. The application MUST be returned to the selection committee fully completed with no missing information.
- 2. The application MUST be returned by the application deadline.
- 3. One personal reference/ letter of recommendation from a person NOT related to applicant is requested. Previous employers, teachers and character references are preferred.
- 4. All awards will be at the sole decision of the board members of the scholarship fund and one at large award selection member as the board determines.
- 5. Recipients will be notified in writing and agree to abide by the requirements of the scholarship.
- 6. Recipient must show enrollment in trade/tech school at time of scholarship award. Award is renewable, until graduation, upon proof of passing grades and continued enrollment in original course of study.
- 7. 4 scholarships will be awarded at \$2000.00 each.

Selection Criteria

Scholarships will be awarded to students who live in Nodaway County Missouri and who are or will be enrolled in a qualified or certified Tech/Trade school, Nursing or Industrial Certification program.

Emphasis will be placed upon:

- 1. Evidence of financial need to achieve career/employment goals.
- 2. Completeness and neatness of application.
- 3. Information from references.
- 4. Evidence of seriousness to achieve career/employment goals.
- 5. Evidence of extracurricular involvement in clubs or organizations which build character or benefit the applicant's community.

Application Procedure

- 1. Fully complete the scholarship application form.
- 2. Fully complete the document describing:
 - Personal and family background
 - Education and career goals/objectives
 - How this scholarship will assist in achieving your goals
 - Any information you choose to provide about income or expenses that make it difficult for you and your family to pay for the cost of your education
 - Any courses, Jobs, life experiences you have completed which will help you prepare for your chosen career
- 3. Attach a separate document listing any extracurricular activities, honors, awards, leadership positions and volunteer service.
- 4. Attach a personal reference/recommendation letter from someone as described in general guidelines section.
- 5. Return application by deadline. Late submissions will not be reviewed.
