Initial \$1000 Scholarship Guidelines for 2020-21 High School Students

1. Applicant must be residing in or attending a Nodaway County school district.
2. Applicant must be a high school senior with a GPA of 2.5/4.0 or better to be eligible for the scholarship.
3. Applicant must demonstrate leadership potential through extracurricular activities and work experiences. Applicant may also demonstrate a need for financial assistance.
4. Handwritten applications will **not** be accepted.
5. Preference may be given to students with their area of study in the field of agriculture and food production. Special preference may be given for areas of study related to beef production. Students pursuing non-agricultural degrees are *encouraged* to apply as EACH Nodaway County school will receive one scholarship if all criteria is met.

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One-Year Renewable \$1000 Scholarship Guidelines (beginning August 2022)

Applicants must have been awarded a Nodaway County Cattlemen's Association Scholarship in 2021 or after –AND- meet the following guidelines:

1. Attend a post-secondary school majoring or minoring in an agriculture related field
2. Attend a post-secondary school in 2022-23 as a full-time student
3. Maintain a 2.5 GPA or above
4. Submit official transcripts verifying the above information by August 15, 2022 to:
